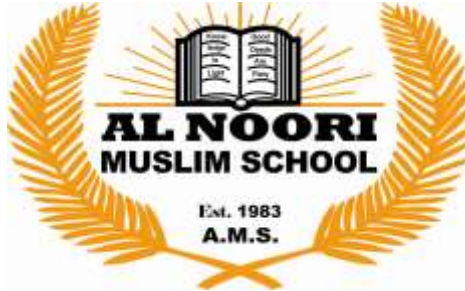

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1. Introduction

The purpose of this document is to outline the facilities available for the students and staff at Al Noori Muslim School. The facilities are to be used by school personnel for teaching and learning purposes as well as school and community events.

2. Classrooms

The primary campus consists of:

- ✓ 18 classrooms for the K-2 students
- ✓ 23 classrooms for the 3-6 students
- ✓ 7 enrichment learning classrooms (small support rooms)

All classrooms are fully furnished with students' desks, chairs, teacher's desk and chair as well as cupboards and shelves for storage. All K-2 classrooms have a wet area consisting of vinyl flooring and a sink with a bubbler.

All classrooms are very well resourced with maths resources, art supplies, stationary supplies as well as reading books, generally available in the class reading corner.

3. Technology

- ✓ The primary campus has one fully equipped computer lab with 30 student desktop computers, one laptop for the teacher as well as one interactive whiteboard.
- ✓ There are 8 classrooms which are equipped with an interactive whiteboard and a further 16 classrooms equipped with a LCD projector.
- ✓ All classrooms have at least one touch screen student desktop computer.
- ✓ The library also has a technology centre consisting of one interactive whiteboard, LCD projector and about 20 student desktop computers.
- ✓ The school's multi-purpose hall also has an interactive whiteboard.
- ✓ The computer lab consists of an interactive whiteboard, LCD projector and 30 student desktop computers.

4. Library

- ✓ The primary campus has one large library, the library is equipped with a technology centre as well as student work areas. The library has a circulation desk with access to the OLIVER network for student and teacher borrowing and returning.

- ✓ The library has thousands of books and teaching resources including maths concrete materials, drama costumes and props as well as literacy games.
- ✓ The library book collection consists of teacher resource books, big books, fictional and non-fictional texts, chapter books, guided readers as well as picture books.

5. Playground facilities

- ✓ The primary play facilities are divided into two main areas:
 - ✓ The K-2 play area
 - ✓ The 3-6 play area
- ✓ Both play areas have synthetic grass surfaces as well as adequate sheltered areas. There are benches in each playground for student seating.
- ✓ There are sports store rooms in each play area which are equipped with age appropriate play equipment that can be accessed by all teachers.
- ✓ The 3-6 playground had a basketball court.

6. Event facilities

- ✓ All school events generally take place in the multi-purpose hall which is located on the Noble ave side of the 3-6 buildings.
- ✓ This hall is a large open space with an in-built speaker system, air conditioning and an interactive whiteboard.

7. Air conditioning

- ✓ All classrooms including the library, hall and computer lab are equipped with at least one air conditioning unit which has heating and cooling options.

8. Staff Facilities

- ✓ There is one main staffroom for all staff in the administrative block and a coffee room located in the centre of the school.
- ✓ The language staff have their own staffroom located in the centre of the school.

- ✓ The staffrooms are equipped with staff lounge furniture, tables and chairs, microwaves, fridges, kettles (the main staffroom has a hot water unit).
- ✓ The staffrooms are also equipped with photocopying facilities and computers for staff use.
- ✓ There are two office blocks in the primary campus.
- ✓ There are 4 individual offices for school executive staff.

9. Canteen Facilities

- ✓ There are two canteens in the primary campus. The main canteen is located in the 3-6 playground; this canteen has a fully equipped kitchen with cooking facilities.
- ✓ The K-2 canteen is a selling point for snacks and drinks.

10. Sick Bay Facilities

- ✓ There is one sick bay which is centrally located. The sick bay is equipped with a fridge for the storage of medications, a sick bay bed, seating for injured students, cupboards for storage of first aid materials as well as an air conditioner unit for heating and cooling.

11. Bathroom Facilities

For students:

- ✓ There are 5 bathroom blocks for female students and 5 bathroom blocks for male students. The bathroom blocks are conveniently located. The bathroom blocks can be found:
 - Block 1- In the K-2 play ground
 - Block 2- First floor in the K-2 building
 - Block 3- Second floor in the K-2 building
 - Block 4- First floor in the 3-6 building
 - Block 5- Beside the multi-purpose hall

For staff:

- ✓ There are bathrooms available for male and females in the main administrative block, the coffee room and a block beside the multi-purpose hall.
