The recipients of the 2022 Academic Achievement Awards were Sumaya Haddad and Ahmad Shuaib. This award recognises the consistent application to their studies.


Citizenship Award

STUDENTS AND SOCIAL MEDIA USE

Al Noori Muslim School teachers encourage and teach responsible and safe use of the internet and online applications. The school's official online platforms for students are Microsoft Office 365, Outlook, and MS Teams. These platforms are monitored by the school to ensure all students abide by our responsible and safe practices that are also in line with the school's Islamic ethos. We have filtering systems to ensure students are not exposed to anything deemed unsafe or inappropriate.

Many parents have enquired about their child's use of the platform, Discord. The school does not support the use of Discord by students; rather this platform is being used by students mainly to avoid the school's monitoring process. Parents are responsible for their child's online activity and the decision to allow students to use Discord or any other online application is at the discretion of the parents.




TERM 3 REFLECTION
