- **Years 11** First day for Year 11 students will be Monday the 30th of January 2023.
- **Years 12** First day for Year 12 students will be Monday the 30th of January 2023.

SCHOOL UNIFORM DEPARTMENT

Students are expected to attend school every day wearing clean, neat, and well-presented uniforms.

Stationery


