AL NOORI MUSLIM SCHOOL

1.0 Introduction

The wearing of the Al Noori Muslim School uniform by students is an outward presentation of pride and respect for both self and the school. It helps build self-confidence and a sense of connection and belonging within our community.

The wearing of the Al Noori Muslim School uniform is compulsory for all students. The school expects students to wear the uniform during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when engaged in school activities out of school hours. The uniform must always be neat and well presented. Dirty, torn, or damaged uniforms are unacceptable. **Unofficial uniforms and logos are not accepted at the school.**

Any potential hazards that have a likelihood to harm the health and safety of any student whilst at school have been incorporated into this policy. For example:

- Primary students in particular must wear a hat for outside activities.
- Students are required to wear appropriate footwear and other protective clothing to avoid injury.
- Jewellery or other items that could cause an injury to themselves or other students are not permitted.

The parents/caregivers and students are informed of the uniform policy and procedures at the time of enrolment and are reminded and updated through the school newsletter and regular memos and/or announcements.

2.0 School Uniform Requirements

1. **Wearing of Al Noori Muslim School uniform is compulsory.**
2. Students must be in full school uniform at all times during school hours, while travelling to and from school and, when engaged in school activities unless stated otherwise.
3. **The school uniform must be worn in its entirety i.e., the hijab forms part of the girls' uniform and should not be removed while other uniform items are worn. This includes whilst outside of school.**
4. In accordance with Health and Safety requirements, students must wear full leather enclosed shoes to school. Slip-on shoes, open style shoes, canvas shoes, sport shoes and high heels are **not** permitted. Appropriate and supportive footwear must be worn for all sporting activities. **Facial coverings are not permitted during sport or physical activities.**
5. School hats and caps are part of the school uniform. Students may wear school caps or visors when outside. When students are outside without a hat or cap, they may be required to stay in the shade.

3.0 Primary School Uniform Requirements

Full school uniform must be worn at all times.

Sport uniforms must only be worn on sport days.

- NO hat. Play in the shade!
- Girls in Years 2-6 MUST wear hijabs.
- Pinafore must be worn in Years K-4 and skirts in Years 5 and 6.
- All boys must have short standard haircuts. Students will be sent home for lack of adherence.
- Students must be well presented at all times.
- Black school shoes are to be worn, no slip-on shoes (rabens or ballerinas).
- White sports shoes are to be worn on sports days.
- Al Noori school bags are compulsory for all students.

4.0 High School Uniform Requirements

It is essential that parents/caregivers take the time to ensure their children are coming to school in correct, clean, and presentable uniform. This maintains both the Islamic and disciplinary standards the school aims to foster as well as ensuring a level of equality and self-confidence amongst students.

Parents/caregivers are asked to ensure the following uniform requirements are met to avoid having their child be subjected to disciplinary measures.

Girls:

- School-issued white chiffon stitched scarf only. The school has a no-pin policy for girls' scarves. Two-piece cotton scarves must be worn with the sports uniform.
- Girls are to ensure their undergarments such as singlets are not coloured particularly if they can be seen under their shirts.
- No jewellery such as bracelets, rings, or necklaces. These will be confiscated and returned to parents/caregivers.
- All girls must wear opaque black stockings. Short socks and tights are not permitted. Long crew socks to be worn with sports uniform. Navy or Black crew socks only.
- Black, closed, leather school shoes. Girls must not wear ballet flats as they do not cover enough of the foot to meet Work, Health & Safety (WHS) regulations.
- No form of make-up, artificial nails or excessive/strong perfume is permitted. This includes permanent eyelash tints and/or eyelash curl.

Boys:

- Clean, iron-pressed shirts and ties at all times.
- Short standard haircuts; no undercuts or step-cuts. Students will be sent home for lack of adherence.
- Boys are to ensure their undergarments such as singlets are not coloured particularly if they can be seen under their shirts.
- No jewellery. These will be confiscated and returned to parents/caregivers.
- Proper sport shoes for PDHPE and sport. No Converse or Rabens.
- Black, closed, leather school shoes.
- Boys must wear black belts.
- No excessive or strong perfume is permitted for boys.

5.0 Procedures for students not wearing the school uniform

If for any reason a child is out of full school uniform for a day, a note from the parents/caregivers must be sent to the school explaining the reason. This should be presented to the classroom teacher (Primary) or Welfare Coordinators (Secondary). A parent note does not justify a student's lack of adherence to the School Uniform Policy. Parents/caregivers are expected to support their child adhering to the policy.

The following procedures are followed if the correct uniform is not being worn:

- In minor cases the Class Teacher (Primary), or Welfare Coordinators (Secondary) may warn the student in the first instance for wearing incorrect uniform and formally inform the students that the correct uniform is to be purchased and worn the following day.
- When significant parts of the uniform are not worn correctly, the Grade Instructional Leader (Primary) or Welfare Coordinators (Secondary) may contact parents/caregivers and the student may be sent home to correct their uniform.
- Students who continue to wear incorrect uniform will be addressed by the Deputy Principal (Primary) or Welfare Coordinators (Secondary). Parents/caregivers will be contacted, and the school Discipline Policy will be applied.
- Should students continue to wear incorrect uniform after their parents/caregivers have been contacted by the Deputy Principal (Primary) or Welfare Coordinators (Secondary) and consequences have been applied, a student could be suspended for continued non-compliance. The student will also be sent home to correct their uniform.
- If a student is persistently not dressed in full school uniform, parents/caregivers will be contacted to discuss the uniform policy and the consequences of not complying with school policies. A student's enrolment at the school is reviewed.

Students and their parents/caregivers have the right to appeal these decisions through submissions to the principal.

6.0 Personal Hygiene

Students must be well presented at all times.

- Students must ensure their uniform is clean and washed regularly, particularly after physical activities to avoid body odour embedded clothing.
- Girls with long hair must have their hair tied up and from Year 2 onwards must wear the Hijab.
- Boys must have a short, plain haircut of even length, all over (no undercuts, hair products or extreme hairstyles).
- Fingernails must be kept short and clean, with no nail polish or artificial nails.
- No forms of jewellery are permitted.
- Students are not permitted to wear excessive or strong perfumes.

7.0 Uniform Department

Al Noori Muslim School's Uniform Department is located at 85 Mimosa Road, Greenacre, NSW 2190. The Uniform Department stocks the complete school uniform and sports uniforms, except for shoes.

Open: **Mondays** and **Wednesdays** from 8:10 am to 10:30 am
(school terms only)

Closed: Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday
